During Site establishment works at the Shell service station at Bell st, Pascoe Vale South asbestos was detected requiring appropriate environmental management practices in order to manage the risk profile of the site.

Working closely with our client Kingdom Projects Pty Ltd on behalf of Hungry Jacks and alongside Shell RMS was contracted to abate up to 1000 tonne of Asbestos containing material (ACM) on the project providing a package of works including detailed excavation, abatement, loading, cartage and disposal.

During the process RMS worked with Worksafe and Shell to shut down operations at the service station for 7 days to manage any potential risk to patrons while the abatement process was taking place.

Working hand in hand with our client RMS we were able to minimise down time for the service station, complete detailed excavation works to ensure no damage to services, manage the risk profile of the project for its customer Kingdom Projects and provide an end to end solution for the effective management and final disposal of previously ACM. The Abatement works on site provided a savings of in excess of \$40.00 per tonne + GST.
